GENERAL

1. In accordance with the guidelines / principles laid down in order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in T.M.A. Pai Foundation and others Vs. State of Karnataka and others; Writ Petition No 317 of 1993 delivered in 31.10.2002, and thereafter in the case of Islamic Academy of Education versus State of Karnataka and others delivered on 14.8.2003, on behalf of Association of Private Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of Jharkhand would be conducting Common Pre Medical Entrance Examination 2010-11 to offer admission to BHMS course. The duration of the course will be Four and a Half Years followed by one year of Compulsory Rotatory Internship (Non Paid). The curriculum is based on the directives of Central Council of Homoeopathy, New Delhi. The Entrance Examination will be conducted after approval from the Permanent Committee, constituted by the Govt. of Jharkhand and is headed by Sri Vikramaditya, Retd. Justice of Hon'ble Jharkhand High Court.

The above degree course will be offered at the following institution in Jharkhand:

- i) Singhbhum Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Jamshedpur
 - ii) The Homoeopathic Medical College of Mihijam, Mihijam.
2. The eligible candidates who are selected through the Common Pre Medical Entrance Examination 2010-11, will be given admission to BHMS courses in the above colleges after counseling on merit basis.
 3. The Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examinations for admission to BHMS Course for

the session 2010-11 shall be held **on 20th June 2010 (Sunday) from 2 PM to 4 PM.**

4. The Centers of examinations would be located in the following places:
- i) ADL SOCIETY HIGH SCHOOL, SAKCHI, JAMSHEDPUR
 - ii) IGNOU CENTRE, KORAPARA, MIHIJAM, JAMTARA.

Note: The centre can be changed if there are not enough candidate in a centre.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Age: Only those candidates whose date of birth falls on or before 31st December 1992 (at least 17 years of age on 31st December 2010) are eligible to apply. Date of Birth as recorded in the High School or its equivalent certificate alone will be accepted.

Reservation : Reservation Policy as per Jharkhand Government entitlement.

Qualification and Minimum Marks: The candidate who have passed the 10+2 i.e. I.Sc/Intermediate examination or its equivalent with Physics, Chemistry and Biology shall be eligible. The candidate must have passed in I.Sc/Equivalent in Physics, Chemistry and Biology in the qualifying examination. The candidates who are appearing for the qualifying examination (XII) and results are not yet available may appear in the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination, but such candidates shall submit the mark sheet of the qualifying examination (XII) on or before 31st August 2010.

SCOPE OF EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION

1. All candidates should appear for the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination. The entrance examination will comprise of an objective type examination of 120 minutes duration containing 100 questions. The distribution of questions for subjects will be Physics: 25; Chemistry: 25 and Biology: 50. The syllabus for entrance examination will be 10+2 examination (CBSE/ISCE/Jharkhand Board or its equivalent). The question paper will be in English.
2. All questions will be objective type with multiple choice of which only one will be correct. Each correct answer shall be awarded one mark. No marks will be awarded against the question which has not been tried. Zero mark will be given for wrong answer. There will be no negative marking. Evaluation will be done by panel of teachers appointed for the purpose.

ANSWERING METHOD

1. Candidate should not indicate the answer sheet in any other way except asked for in the examination paper.
2. If more than one answer is tick marked for one question, the answer will be considered as wrong.

3. If candidate wants to change answer sheet , it is permitted with permission of the Centre in-charge, but no extra time will be given to such candidate.
4. Candidate should not do any rough work or writing work on the answer sheet. All rough work should be done in the separate sheet which will be provided with the answer sheet.

APPLICATION FORM

- A candidate appearing in the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination is required to send his/her application on the prescribed form appended in the information brochure. Candidate should not fill more than one form for the entrance examination.
- Before filling up the Application Form , the candidate must familiarize himself/herself with the information given in this brochure and should satisfy his/her eligibility to appear in the examination. The candidate is required to go through the information brochure carefully and acquaint himself/herself with all requirements with regards to the filling-in of Application form.
- Application form should be filled in English only.
- Application form should be filled in candidates own handwriting. Any error arising on this account shall be the responsibility of the candidate.
- The candidate should write his/her complete address and contact number for further correspondence. Pin Code must be given in the address. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct address in the application form is written. Association/Colleges shall not be held responsible for any loss in transit or for an incorrect address given by the application form.
- **The last date for receipt of application form is 15th June 2010.**
- Candidate should write his/her preference of college clearly in the given place in the form.
- Affix a recent (not taken before 30.3.2010) passport size photograph in the space provided in the application form. Candidates are required to put their signature in the box given in the bottom of the photograph.
- Change in any particulars in the Application Form shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- Incomplete application form or with over-writing will be rejected.
- Candidates are required to submit only One Application Form. If a candidate submits more than one form, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled.

The application form must be accompanied with:

1. Attested photocopy of High School / ICSE / Class X or its equivalent pass certificate as proof of date of birth.
2. Attested photocopy of the mark sheets of the qualifying examination (10+2 or its

equivalent) from a recognized Board/University.

Furnishing of false information or suppression of any information would disqualify the candidate from the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination / Admission and cancellation of admission if already admitted. If considered necessary, legal action may also be taken against such a candidate.

ADMIT CARD

1. The admit card will be sent to the candidate by Speed Post / Courier. In case the Admit Card is not received by 18th June 2010, the candidate should contact the concerned college where the application was sent with a Photograph (as pasted in the application form), photocopy of application form for getting duplicate Admit Cards.
2. The Admit Card will bear the candidates Roll Number, Examination Centre address. Candidate's name, address, photograph and signature. The candidate should carefully examine the Admit Card received by him/her for all the entries made therein. In case of any discrepancy, the candidate should immediately inform the concerned college where the application was sent.
3. Entry to the examination hall will be restricted to candidates not in possession of Admit Card. In no case would a duplicate Admit Card be issued at the Examination Centre.
4. Candidates are advised to preserve their Admit Card in good condition till admission in the college. Those who claim to be considered in the Reserved Category, shall produce appropriate document at the time of counseling / interview.

EXAMINATION

1. **The Common Pre-medical Entrance Examination will be held on 20th June 2010 (Sunday) from 02-00 PM to 04-00 PM.**
2. Admit card will be sent to all eligible candidates at their postal address. The college shall not be responsible for non-receipt or delay of admit cards due to loss in transit or any other ground. Admit card will not be sent to ineligible candidates and no correspondence in this regard shall be entertained nor shall the fees be refunded.
3. Candidates must reach their examination centre at least 30 minutes before the commencement of examination. No candidate will be allowed in the examination 15 minutes after the commencement of examination.
4. Candidates must hand over the answer sheet to the invigilator before leaving the examination hall.
5. Candidates are not allowed to bring any books, text material, calculator, mobile phones, paging device, slide rulers, log tables or laptop to the examination hall.
6. Any conversation or gesticulation or causing disturbance in the examination hall shall lead to debarring the candidates from taking the entrance examination.
7. Candidate must sign the attendance sheet in the presence of the invigilator.
8. Candidate must arrange their own stay in connection with the Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination. If you live far away from the venue, it is prudent to reach the city on the previous day itself. It is also advised to locate the examination

centre beforehand.

ADMISSION

1. Candidate if after joining, remains absent for continuously for 30 days without any intimation will be presumed not interested in pursuing the course and the seat shall be treated as vacant and will be allotted to other eligible candidate.
2. A candidate who had qualified for admission to the course, shall have to deposit the prescribed full fee at the time of admission. Those who fail to do so will lose their claim for admission.
3. Admission in course shall be given only after the candidate produces the original of the following documents at the office of Principal of the respective college:
 - i) High School Certificate as proof of date of Birth.
 - ii) Mark Sheet of the qualifying examination.
 - iii) Certificate of the qualifying examination.
 - iv) Character certificate , if applicable.
 - v) SC/ST/OBC Certificate if applicable.
 - vi) Admit Card of Common Pre-Medical Entrance Examination 2010-11
 - vii) Eight Passport size and three stamp size photographs.
4. All certificates are subject to verification of authenticity of facts from the original certificate and documents of candidates. The decision of the management regarding the eligibility of any applicant shall be final.

FEE STRUCTURE

As per the directive of Dept. of Health, Govt. of Jharkhand the fee structure is as follows:

- i) Annual Tuition Fee: Rs. 25,000/- per annum.
- ii) Miscellaneous Fee: Rs. 3,000/- per annum.
- iii) Security Deposit: Rs. 5,000/- per annum. (Refundable after passing out)
